

## Comprehensive Perinatal Services Program (CPSP) Providers

All pregnant Central Coast Alliance for Health members (and pregnancy only Medi-Cal recipients) are eligible for CPSP services. The Perinatal Care provider (PCP), Obstetrician (OB), Midwife or member can refer to CPSP by telephone. It is best done early in the pregnancy, as it provides a number of support services in addition to medical care.

CPSP enhanced services include assessment, intervention and referral for:

- nutrition
- health education
- psychosocial services

They also provide Case coordination, Perinatal and parenting education and Vitamin/mineral supplements.
