## What is CaREDIE?

- California Reportable Disease Information Exchange (CaREDIE) is the California Department of Public Health's (CDPH) communicable disease reporting and surveillance system of record.
- It is used by state and local public health officials and healthcare providers for communicable disease reporting and surveillance.
